# **Code of Discipline for Students**

In order to maintain a safe, respectful, and supportive learning environment, all students are expected to comply with the following rules and standards:

# 1. Attendance & Punctuality

- Students are required to attend school regularly and arrive punctually.
- Absences due to valid reasons must be reported in writing to the Vice Principal.
- Any unexplained absence of six (6) consecutive school days must be justified to the satisfaction of the Vice Principal.
- Students who are unwell must remain at home until fully recovered.

#### 2. Behavior & Conduct

- All students must treat teachers, staff, and peers with courtesy and respect.
- Bullying, intimidation, harassment, or fighting will not be tolerated and will result in disciplinary action.
- Students may not leave the school premises during the school day except in emergencies and only with the written approval of the Vice Principal, based on the class teacher's recommendation.

# 3. Dress & Appearance

- Students are required to wear the prescribed school uniform neatly and modestly.
- Girls may wear only simple earrings or studs.
- Boys must maintain a neat haircut; extreme hairstyles are not permitted.

#### 4. Prohibited Items

- Students may bring only school-related items, such as textbooks, library books, and necessary stationery.
- Items such as comics, video games, harmful toys, or unauthorized electronic devices are strictly prohibited.
- Mobile phones may only be used with explicit permission from the school.
- Any media, online content, or games deemed inappropriate by the school are prohibited.

### 5. Respect for Property

- Students are responsible for the safekeeping of their belongings. The school will not be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Any damage to school property must be reported immediately and will be charged to the student's parents/guardians.

### 6. Health & Safety

- Smoking, drugs, and alcohol are strictly prohibited. Possession or use of such substances may result in expulsion.
- Students must comply with all safety regulations and emergency procedures.

### 7. Parents & Visitors

- Parents/guardians and friends are not permitted to enter classrooms.
- Parents may meet their children or teachers only with prior approval from the Vice Principal, by appointment, and in the designated visitors' area.

## 8. Disciplinary Measures

Violations of school rules will result in progressive disciplinary action, which may include:

- 1. Verbal or written warning.
- 2. Suspension from classes.
- 3. Expulsion in cases of severe or repeated misconduct.
